On Monday, Governor Whitmer announced a “stay home, stay safe” order for all of Michigan until April 13th. Because of this order, we will be making the following changes:

Building Hours:

- Both the Middle/High and the Elementary will be closed until this order is lifted.
- We will be monitoring phone calls to the schools. If you need to contact the school, call and leave a message. Your call will be returned within 24 hours.
- If you need to reach a teacher, please use email or Remind. Teachers will continue to educate students through the online platforms while we are closed.

Lunch Service:

- We will continue to serve lunches on Tuesday's from 11:00am to 1:00pm.
- Families may pick up lunches for the entire week at this time.
- There must be no person to person contact. The lunches will be placed on a table for pick up.

Technology/Instruments:

- We will not be able to provide an additional day to pick up Chromebooks or instruments. This is, once again, to minimize contact and to follow the governor's order.
- We will revisit this possibility after the order is lifted.

Academics:

- We are paying very close attention to any and all announcements from the government regarding schools. While we are concerned about all of our students, we are most concerned about our graduating senior class. We will do everything we can to help our students graduate this year. Continue to complete assignments because it will count for the students.
- We will pass on any information as we receive it.

Throughout all of this, what is most difficult for many of us is the fact that we miss our loved ones. Please know that we miss all of our students and families as well. We hope that you all, like us, are doing your best to reach out to friends and families in different ways. Call, write, even use Facetime to check on the people you care about. We need each other's support as we try to make the best of a challenging situation.

Tecnología /Instrumentos:

- No podremos proporcionar un día adicional para recoger Chromebooks o instrumentos. Esto es, una vez más, para minimizar el contacto y seguir la orden del gobernador.
- Revisaremos esta posibilidad después de que se levante la orden.

Académica:
