Dear Hope of Detroit K-4 Family,

Monday we informed you that teachers are working hard to prepare for ongoing education as we adjust to a new chapter in our 20 year history. In today's communication, We will be going over the plan more specifically for the elementary students. We feel that we need to adjust our approach with the students' age and abilities in mind. Therefore, you will not see Google Classroom assignments posted that some other older students may receive. This is done intentionally because we are concerned about our students being able to effectively use this without enough guided practice (or even introduction to it with our younger students). The plan moving forward is this:

All teachers are working in teams to prepare a weekly plan for the students by grade level. This plan will be posted on Remind, the school Facebook page, and our school website. This will begin on Monday, March 23rd. The plan will cover several subjects and will have a daily assignment for each. Many of the assignments will be using the online subscriptions that the students already use in class.

This means, as we mentioned in the previous letter, that students will need access to the internet to do the planned assignments. We understand that this presents a challenge to some of our families. We strongly encourage everyone to get more information from cable companies about free internet. Here is another option from Spectrum: call 1-844-488-8398 for free internet during the school shutdown. We hope that families are able to provide this option because it is the most effective and relevant option for our students. If this is not possible, please contact the school during our new business hours at 313-897-8720 (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday 9:00am - 2:00pm).

The school will be providing technology sign outs for families who do not have a way to provide it at home. A parent or guardian will need to sign a technology agreement in order to check out a chromebook or laptop. If a parent is not able to come up during school hours, someone may pick up a form for them to sign and return to school. They will then be provided with their technology.

Those kindergarten, first and second grade students who need it, will be provided a school iPad. Third and fourth grade students who need technology will be provided a chromebook.

These may be checked out on Thursday, March 19 from 9:00am - 2:00p.m. If you are not able to come at this time, please call the school.

We are also aware that childcare for our students may look different in many households. It is strongly recommended that families set a schedule for their students to complete their assignments each day. A morning and afternoon session with a break in between is a good idea. The students should have a designated work area that will help build the routine. Children can also have daily
